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Instructions for formatting the title page are on p. 23 of the 6<sup>th</sup> edition of the *Publication Manual of the American Psychological Association* (APA). A sample is on p. 41. A title should say what the paper is about, not only what the assignment is. A running head should include key words that could be used if someone were doing a web search for your paper. Note that all elements in the header are on the same line, and the other lines on the title page include very specific information and are centered in the top half of the page.

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
